

DIFFERENT TYPES OF SINNERS #1 FOOLS

1. Deny God. Ps 14:1 ; 53:1 .

Psa 14¹ The fool says in his heart, “There is no God.”

2. Blaspheme God.

Ps 74¹⁸ Remember this, *that* the enemy hath reproached, O LORD, and *that* the foolish people have blasphemed thy name.

3. Make a mock at sin.

Pr 14:⁹ Fools make a mock at sin:

4. Despise instruction.

Pr 1:⁷ The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Hate knowledge. Pr 1:22 .

5. Sport themselves in mischief.

Pr 10:²³ A fool finds pleasure in evil conduct, NIV

6. Walk in darkness

Ec 2:14 ...but the fool walketh in darkness:

7. Are

a. Self-sufficient.

Pr 12:¹⁵ The way of a fool *is* right in his own eyes:

b. Self-confident.

Pr 14:¹⁶ A wise *man* feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.

c. Self-deceivers.

Pr 14⁸ The wisdom of the prudent is to give thought to their ways, but the folly of fools is deception. NIV

d. Can't control the their mouth

1. Full of words

Ec 10:¹⁴ and the fool multiplies words. No one knows what is coming— who can tell him what will happen after him? NIV

2. Given to meddling.

Pr 20:but every fool will be meddling.

3. Slanders and lies

Pr 10:18 ...he that uttereth a slander, *is* a fool.

4. Contentious.

Pr 18:6 A fool's lips enter into contention, and his mouth calleth for strokes. ⁷ A fool's mouth *is* his destruction, and his lips *are* the snare of his soul.

5. Destroy themselves by their speech.

Pr 10:8 The wise in heart accept commands,
but a chattering fool comes to ruin. NIV

e. Slothful

Ec 4:5 The fool folds his hands and ruins himself. NIV

h. Lives in anger

Ec 7:9for anger resteth in the bosom of fool.

8. A grief to parents

Pr 17:25 ²⁵ A foolish son *is* a grief to his father, and bitterness to her that bare him.

9. Come to shame.

Pr 3:35 ³⁵ The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools.

10. Bring others to ruin

Pr 13:20 ... but a companion of fools shall be destroyed .

Pr 9 6 Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding.

11. Shall not stand in the presence of God.

Ps 5:5 ⁵ The foolish shall not stand in thy sight:

12. The fool will be punished.

Ps 107:17 ¹⁷ Some became fools through their rebellious ways
and suffered affliction because of their iniquities.

Pr 19:29 Judgments are prepared for scorers, and stripes for the back of fools.
