

HEALING #3 SIX WORDS FOR HEALING

Acts 3¹ Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, *being* the ninth *hour* .² And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;³ Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms.⁴ And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us.⁵ And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them.⁶ Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.⁷ And he took him by the right hand, and lifted *him* up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.⁸ And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.¹

Psa 107 20 "He sent his word and healed them".

1. STEREOO-STEROIDS

a. v- 7 "received strength"

4732 στερεόω [*stereo* / ster-eh· o ·o /] v . From 4731 ; TDNT 7:609 ; TDNTA 1077 ; GK 5105 ; Three occurrences; AV translates as "receive strength" once, "make strong" once, and "establish" once. 1 to make solid, make firm, strengthen, make strong. 1A of the body of anyone²

b. Stereo – it is where we get the word for stereo. It makes louder and stronger.

c. Steroids- people have been kicked out of the Olympics because they have taken steroids. Why? It makes you stronger.

Immediately his ankles received strength.

God can strengthen you in the time of your weakness.

Every disease that causes weakness He has a cure for.

2. IAOMAI (ee'ah om ahee) healed
 - a. v 11 “and the lame man was healed”
 - b. greek word is healed
 - c. **2390 ἰάομαι** [*iaomai* / ee·**ah**·om·ahee /] v . Middle voice of apparently a primary verb; TDNT 3:194 ; TDNTA 344 ; GK 2615 ; 28 occurrences; AV translates as “heal” 26 times, and “make whole” twice. **1** to cure, heal. **2** to make whole. 2a to free from errors and sins, to bring about (one's) salvation.

3. HOLOKLERIA- inheritance

Acts 3¹⁶ And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all. ¹³

- a. **3647 ὀλοκληρία** [*holokleria* / hol·ok·lay·**ree**·ah /] n f . From 3648 ; TDNT 3:767 ; TDNTA 442 ; GK 3907 ; AV translates as “perfect soundness” once. **1** of an unimpaired condition of the body, in which all its members are healthy and fit for use. 1a good health.

- c. kleria –your inheritance- when he received the Messiah he didn't get what belonged to someone else, he received all that was his heritage in Christ Jesus.

Same used in the O.T. for Jubilee. Every 50 every debt was canceled, you could return to your possession and possess it.

“This man stands before you in his full inheritance.”

4. Made whole- “Sozo”

ACTS 4 9 If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole;⁵

- a. Sozo is the Greek word for salvation; to be changed.
- b. Included in his healing was his salvation.
- c. In your salvation is your healing.

5. Hugies- whole

Acs 4 ¹⁰ Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, *even* by him doth this man stand before you whole. ⁶

5199 ὅγιος [*hugies* / hoog-ee· ace /] adj . From the base of 837 ; TDNT 8:308 ; TDNTA 1202 ; GK 5618 ; 14 occurrences; AV translates as “whole” 13 times, and “sound” once. **1** sound. **1A** of a man who is sound in body. **2** to make one whole i.e. restore him to health. **3** metaph. teaching which does not deviate from the truth.

6. THERAPUEO- HEALED

2323 θεραπεύω [*therapeuo* / ther·ap· yoo ·o /] v . From the same as 2324 ; TDNT 3:128 ; TDNTA 331 ; GK 2543 ; 44 occurrences; AV translates as “heal” 38 times, “cure” five times, and “worship” once. **1** to serve, do service. **2** to heal, cure, restore to health.

Not only healed but had therapy. This the word for medical practice. Jesus did it all in one healing. He could not have walked without complete healing!

The progression of your healing begins with your spirit, then your soul, and into your body. 1Th 5 23
