THE HOLY SPIRIT OUR ENPOWERMENT

1Sa. 16 The Lord said to Samuel, “How long will you mourn for Saul, since I have rejected him as king over Israel? Fill your horn with oil and be on your way; I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem. I have chosen one of his sons to be king.”

¹² So he sent and had him brought in. He was ruddy, with a fine appearance and handsome features.

Then the Lord said, “Rise and anoint him; he is the one.”

¹³ So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and from that day on the Spirit of the Lord came upon David in power. Samuel then went to Ramah. NIV

I. THE HORN

A. The horn was merely a vessel for use.

Our body is **a temple** of the Holy Spirit. 1Co. 6

Our body was made to **glorify God in the world**.

Our body is to be **a vessel of righteousness**.

B. It was hollowed out for use.

Everything that was in the horn had to be removed.

Our lives need a good cleaning out of everything that would prevent us from being full of the Spirit.

2Co. 7 Since we have these promises, dear friends, let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God.

C. It had to be **empty** before it could be filled.

Thus the words hunger, thirst, seek, and etc. expresses our need to be filled with the Spirit. But to be filled requires that we be empty.

If not we are full of something else. The “something else” must go!

II. THE OIL

A. The is a type of the Holy Spirit

B. The oil was to be “poured out.”

C. We are not to go “until”.

Luke 24⁴⁹ I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.”

We can't go until we have received the “oil”.

III. THE ANOINTING

A. The **PURPOSE** of anointing is for “going”.

The reason the Spirit of God is not moving upon us is because we are “staying” instead of going. We will be anointed as we go.

B. The **PERSON** for the anointing is **pointed out.-David**
V12... Then the Lord said, “Rise and anoint him; he is the one.”

C. The **PRESENCE** of the anointing will be **witnessed by others.**

¹³ So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him **in the presence of his brothers,.....**

D. The **POWER** of the anointing will be felt by you.

V13..... and from that day on the Spirit of the Lord came upon David **in power.**

Let's fill our horn with oil and go, others will then me touched by the Spirit!
