THE ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION OF THE HOLY
SPIRIT

1Co. 12⁴ There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit.⁵
There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord.⁶ There are
different kinds of working, but the same God works all of them in
all men.

⁷ Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the
common good. NIV

1Co. 12⁴ Now there are **diversities of gifts**, but the same Spirit.⁵
And there are **differences of administrations**, but the same Lord.

⁶ And there are **diversities of operations**, but it is the same God
which worketh all in all.⁷ But the **manifestation** of the Spirit is
given to every man to profit withal. KJV

The Holy Spirit is explained as manifesting himself in many ways.
We shall be looking at the different administrations, operations and
movings of the Spirit. He is spoken of as, being **with, on, in, and
coming out** of the believer. What does each of these moves
imply?

I. He is **with us at Salvation**.

John 14¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another
Counselor to be with you forever—¹⁷ the Spirit of truth. The world
cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But
you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

A. He is with us as a Counselor

1. The word Counselor in Greek is “parakletos”. It is
Interpreted Comforter or Counselor in John 14:16,26; 15:26, 16:7
and Advocate in 1Jn 2:1.

2. It means one called to the side of another for help or counsel.

3. The Holy Spirit is our Paraclete or Helper on the earth and Christ is the Paraclete or Helper in heaven.

4. “Another Comforter” implies one of the same. Jesus is saying He is sending one like himself.

B. He is with us as a Counselor of Truth.

John 14 ²⁶ But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. NIV

1. He will teach you

He will not lie. He is come to show us the truth of the New Will and Testament of Jesus Christ.

2. He will bring truth to your remembrance.

C. He is with us as a Counselor we know!

John 14 17... But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

How did they know Him?

He is telling the disciples that they have experienced him at some level already. Not the fullness of the Spirit but the dealings of the Spirit.

1. When they operated under the Kingdom authority of Jesus.
When the 70 disciples were sent out in pairs.

Luke 10 4 They were not to take money, a garment bag, nor an extra pair of sandals.

V9 ⁹ **Heal the sick** who are there and tell them, ‘The kingdom of God is near you.’

¹⁷ The seventy-two returned with joy and said, “Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name.”

2. When they were saved.

¹⁸ He replied, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. ¹⁹ **I have given you authority** to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. ²⁰ However, **do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.**”

D. The world does not know him.

John 14 17.... The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him.

Why?

John 3 3 In reply Jesus declared, “I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again.”

⁵ Jesus answered, “I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. ⁶ Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. ⁷ You should not be surprised at my saying, ‘**You must be born again.**’

The world does not know him because they have not been born again! We know him as being with us because we have been born again.

E. He is to be with us as a Counselor forever.

John 14 ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever....

He will not be with us until the rapture and then be taken from the earth as some teach! He will be here during the tribulation, Millennium, and forever. To have the Holy Spirit removed out of the world would mean to nullify the benefits of the N.T. for men.

The only way that people can be saved is by the Spirit giving them birth and bringing them into the kingdom of God. He is here forever. It is never mentioned anywhere in scripture the Spirit will leave.

He is indeed ever-present!
