THE ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION OF THE HOLY
SPIRIT
“ON”

1Co. 12⁴ There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit.⁵
There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord.⁶ There are
different kinds of working, but the same God works all of them in
all men.

⁷ Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the
common good. NIV

We have learned that the Holy Spirit is with us as a Counselor and
Comforter. He teaches, guides, brings truth to our remembrance,
and is with us forever. We operate under kingdom authority. This
we all have at salvation.

What happens when the Spirit comes on us?

I. In the O.T. He comes to anoint temporarily.

* Moses and the 70 elders

- Num. 11²⁵ Then the Lord came down in the cloud

1Sa. 10¹⁰ When they arrived at Gibeah, a and spoke with him, and
he took of the Spirit that was on him and put the Spirit on the
seventy elders. When the Spirit rested on them, they prophesied,
but they did not do so again.

Saul procession of prophets met him; the Spirit of God came upon
him in power, and he joined in their prophesying.

These are types of what the Spirit will be in the N.T.

II. In the N. T. He comes to remain.

A. Jesus becomes the example to us all of what it would be
like to have the Spirit “come on us”.

John 1 ²⁹ The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! ³⁰ This is the one I meant when I said, ‘A man who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.’ ³¹ I myself did not know him, but the reason I came baptizing with water was that he might be revealed to Israel.”

³² Then John gave this testimony: “I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and **remain on him**. ³³ I would not have known him, except that the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, ‘**The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is he who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.**’ ³⁴ I have seen and I testify that this is the Son of God.”

1. Jesus was **conceived** of the Holy Spirit
2. Jesus was **anointed** by the Spirit for a redemptive work. John 1 29 “takes away the sin the world”

Isa. 61 The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners.

3. He was **baptized or clothed** in the Spirit v-33

Jesus in baptism was **washed, anointed, and separated** for service.

He received the power to accomplish His priesthood.

Luke 4 Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the desert, ² where for forty days he was tempted by the devil.

¹³ When the devil had finished all this tempting, he left him until an opportune time. ¹⁴ Jesus **returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit**, and news about him spread through the whole countryside.

B. Pouring, the Promise of the Father, filled with the Holy Ghost and endued (clothed) are all symbols or types for baptism.

Baptism, pouring, and clothes are all “a coming upon” or a covering.

Luke 24⁴⁹ I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been **clothed with power** from on high.”

Acts 1⁸ But you will **receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you**; and you will be my **witnesses** in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

Acts 2² Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting.³ They saw what seemed to be **tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them**.⁴ **All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak** in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Peter explains what has happened in these verses...

Acts 2¹⁴ Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd: “Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, **let me explain this to you**; listen carefully to what I say.¹⁵ These men are not drunk, as you suppose. It’s only nine in the morning!¹⁶ No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel:¹⁷ ““In the last days, God says, **I will pour out my Spirit on** all people. Your sons and daughters will **prophecy**, your young men will **see visions**, your old men will **dream dreams**.¹⁸ Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy.

This would be an experience when the Holy Spirit was not only with, but on us. This experience was not just for the leaders but for all His SERVANTS, BOTH MEN AND WOMEN.

This was no small issue. Women would prophesy. Did this happen? yes

Acts 21⁸ And the next *day* we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea: and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelist, which was *one* of the seven; and abode with him.⁹ And the same man had four daughters, virgins, which did prophesy. NKJ

Young and old would receive the outpouring of the Spirit.

Acts 10⁴⁴ While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.⁴⁵ And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also.⁴⁶ For they heard them **speak with tongues and magnify God.** NKJ

Acts 19⁶ And when Paul had laid *his* hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and **they spake with tongues, and prophesied.**

When the Holy Spirit falls upon us there is a supernatural reaction: tongues, prophesy, praise, dreams and visions.
