THE HOLY SPIRIT FLOWING “OUT” OF US

Review: The Spirit is “**with us**” at Salvation as **Counselor**.
“**on us**” to “**remain**”, to **Anoint**, to be
immersed (**Baptism**) in Him.
“**in us**” to produce the **Fruit of the Spirit**,
to **improve our character** and
to **increase the nature of God** in us
which is **love**.

What we are experiencing the gifts, service, workings and
manifestations of the Spirit. 1CO. 12 4

I will attempt to tie all of this together.

1Co. 12 1-11 List the gifts of the Spirit to be in the body of Christ.
13 Gifts without love are profitless but with love powerful.
14 Regulation of tongues and prophesy.

The Holy Spirit wants balance in our life.

The Corinthians were saved, filled, had the gifts (1Co 1 4-8) but
were short on love and maturity. They were spiritual babes and
living carnal!

Truth about gifts and the user of the gifts

1. Does not make the one being used more holy.
2. Does not mean that the one being used is mature.
3. Does not mean that the one being used is more “spiritual”.
4. It does mean they are willing to be used.
5. The gifts are for service!

What the Holy Spirit wants is to “move on us, through us and out
of us with love in power”.

John 7 “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. ³⁸ He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” ³⁹ But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those ⁷believing in Him would receive; for the ⁸Holy Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified. NKJ

4 OUTFLOWS OF THE SPIRIT

1. EDIFICATION- (RENEWAL)

Jude 1 ²⁰ But you, dear friends, build yourselves up in your most holy faith and pray in the Holy Spirit.

1Co. 14 4 He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself.

We give out continually and must take in. We do so by spending time with God. The Word effects your spirit.

Isaiah 28 ¹¹ For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people, ¹² To whom He said, “This *is* the rest *with which* You may cause the weary to rest,” And, “This *is* the refreshing”; Yet they would not hear. NKJ

The fresh flow of the Spirit is the key to renewal!

2. REVELATION-

Things are hidden from people that aren't spiritually minded.

1Co. 2 For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. ¹¹ For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. ¹² Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

¹³ These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the ⁴Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. ¹⁴ But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.

If it is not clear to you what God wants you to have, if you can't see it, or speak it, it won't happen.

1co. 14 2 speaking in tongues is communicating with God in **mystery**.

3. INTERCESSION

Rom 8 26

Gal. 4 ¹⁹ My little children, for whom I **labor in birth** again until Christ is formed in you, NKJ

Eze. 22 ³⁰ “**I looked for a man** among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found none. NIV

Deliverance, healing, protection over the land and personal well being, church growth, divine intervention takes place when we are in the flow of intercession.

4. POWER-

We are promised the power of God. **The power of God has one purpose: to accomplish the task.**

Power is not a feeling but a result!

A woman with an issue of blood touches Jesus. She was convinced if she could touch him she would be made whole. Be reminded that she did not feel the power but the result of the power.- healing. Jesus felt virtue leave his body when he asked, “Who touched me?”

Jesus has placed his power in the church.

John 14 12 “...he that believes on me, the works that I do she he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto the Father”.

The power is not just in one person but the entire body of Christ.

Eph. 3 ¹⁶ I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and **established in love,** ¹⁸ **may have power, together with all the saints,** to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—**that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.**

²⁰ **Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,** ²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
